If you are interested in joining this thoughtful group of knitting donors, please refer to the guidelines below to help you select appropriate items for donation:

1. Full skeins of any yarn fiber, including but not limited to wool and blends, acrylic and acrylic blends, in all weights from lace to bulky
2. Partial skeins of yarn (rolling them into balls and labeling the fiber is very
3. Books, magazines and/or readable patterns
4. UFOs (unfinished objects) ONLY if there is an accompanying pattern
5. Needles (circular or straight)
6. Notions such as stitch markers, row counters, tape measures, small scissors, etc.
7. Knitted articles you no longer want or wear, but don't want to throw

Some items we cannot use include:

1. Tangled, dirty yarn
2. Musty or smoke-smelling items
