If you are interested in joining this thoughtful group of knitting donors, please refer to the guidelines below to help you select appropriate items for donation:

1. Full skeins of any yarn fiber, including but not limited to, wool and blends, acrylic and acrylic blends, in all weights from lace to bulky.
2. Books, magazines, and readable patterns.
3. Needles (circular or straight)
4. Notions such as stitch markers, row counters, tape measures, small scissors, etc..
5. Gently used/like new knit items

Some items we cannot use include:

1. Partial skeins or balls of yarn
2. Tangled, dirty yarn
3. Musty or smoke-smelling yarn
4. Photocopied patterns
