Thanks to the generosity of so many of our Guild members and people who have heard about this organization, we have received donations of yarn, books, and other knitting-related items to knit things for our service partners, to share with other service knitters, to help teach new knitters to knit, to provide books for the Textile Center library, and to raise money for the Guild

If you are interested in joining this thoughtful group of knitting donors, please refer to the guidelines below to help you select appropriate items for donation:

- 1. Full skeins of any natural fiber or natural fiber blend, such as wool/acrylic, yarns. Please no 100% acrylic
- 2. Books, magazines, and readable patterns.
- 3. Needles (circular or straight)
- 4. Notions such as stitch markers, row counters, tape measures, small scissors, etc...

Some items we cannot use include:

- 1. Partial skeins or balls of yarn
- 2. Tangled, dirty yarn
- 3. Musty or smoke-smelling yarn
- 4. Yarn with pet hair on it
- 5. Photocopied patterns

Please do not drop items off at Minnesota Knitters' Guild meetings or the Textile Center without prior approval.
