Thanks to the generosity of our Guild members and other supporters, we receive many donations of yarn and knitting supplies. We use these items to create handknits for our service partners, share with other service knitters, help teach new knitters, and raise money for the Guild.

If you are interested in joining this thoughtful group of knitting donors, please refer to the guidelines below to help you select appropriate items for donation.

1. We accept yarn that is a full skein with a label. (It is acceptable if the yarn is wound into a cake with the label tucked inside or otherwise attached.) We do not accept partial skeins.
2. We prefer natural fibers or natural fiber blends, such as wool/acrylic. However, we will accept acrylic yarn.
3. Yarn must be clean and free of odors and pet hair. We can only accept yarn that has been kept in a smoke-free home.
4. We have limited capacity to accept books, magazines, patterns, knitting needles, or knitting notions. Please contact the Guild's Service Director at service@knitters.org to ask if we are accepting these items.

If you have items to donate, please email a description of the donation to service@knitters.org. The Service Director will coordinate a hand-off. (Please note, the Minnesota Textile Center cannot accept donations to the Knitters' Guild.)
