Class Summary


Learn geometric knitting techniques while making a beautiful Pinwheel block. Learn ways to create geometric shapes modularly to minimize seaming. We'll be covering the optional construction for this block which is to use Intarsia for Garter Stitch. This technique is very useful for adding small color details to a design. We will make 2 blocks

Gather Class Supplies

Yarn See Color Identification figure at the right. Yarn amounts below are enough to make the 2 blocks you will work on in class.

- 150 yards each of MC
- 150 yards of C2
- 50 yards of C1

DK or Worsted weight are recommended. Choose needles that match yarn weight. All yarns should be in the same weight.



For color ideas, here are some block color combinations from the Pinwheel blanket.

Basic supplies Straight or circular needles that match your yarn weight, tapestry needles or Susan Bates finishing needles, stitch markers, stitch holders or scrap yarn, scissors, crochet hook)

Make 2 Garter Stitch Squares in color C1 for Block

Garter Stitch Square Instructions:

With C1 for Block, cast on 12 sts, using a knitted cast on.

Knit 23 rows.

Place sts on stitch holder or waste yarn. Cut C1.
